Each year, the school creates a report called the School Accountability Report Card. It is a report about the school, how the students perform, how many students are enrolled in each grade, and also highlights areas of improvement. We also share test scores, graduation, and other items such as the number of students that participate in career readiness courses. b. Comprehensive School Improvement (CSI):CSI - we qualify due to graduation

Alta Vista is identified as a CSI (Comprehensive School Improvement School) because our 4-year graduation rate is below the target. That means we need your input to develop a plan that improves student achievement. This school year, we utilized tutoring to help support our students and increase credit completion and graduation rate. We will now do a short activity where you will give input on areas you believe are important for us to focus on this next school year.

c. Differentiated Assistance (DA)

- DA Dashboard - We don't want to be in the red area. Two focus areas.

Alta Vista qualifies for DA because our school dashboard showed some student groups were in the red zone.

We created two teams that work on those areas. One group is focusing on student scores in 11th grade ELA state testing, and the other is the number of students that graduate from our school ready for college or a career.

d. CA School Dashboard

The California School Dashboard is similar to a report card for the school. The report is released to the public in October of each year. It is an easy-to-read website where the school is given color bands, or grades for different categories. If you go to the website www.CASchoolDashboard.org, you can search for our school name. Alta Vista improved in a number of important areas this year. First, our enrollment grew by over 400 students. Our 11th grade state test scores in both English and Math both increased. We also saw that our graduation rate increased. These are important to note, because Alta Vista has worked hard to encourage students' attendance and increase their participation in tutoring. So, well done, students! If you would like a copy of the report, we can print it for you, as well.
